

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers stored (with your consent) on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies allow Advance HE (“we”, “us”, “our” “**Advance HE**”) and our suppliers, who partner with us to help deliver a high quality online experience, to identify you (or, more accurately, your computer) when you visit the online community space (the “**Community Space**”). Knowing how often people are visiting each page helps us work out how and where to improve the Community Space.

Which cookies and cookie-enabled services does Advance HE use?

Details about the cookies we use on the Community Space are set out in the table below.

Service name	Cookies name	Purpose
Add to calendar	addevent_track_cookie	For the button “Add to calendar” an event
Hivebrite	remember_user_token	Allows to keep the user session active and not ask the user to connect again
	user_ID	In order to identify the connected user
	first_user_experience	To identify if it is the first connexion of the user
	cookie_consent	To know if the user accepted the Cookies policies
	search_path	Used for the user search
	admin_id	To identify which admin he/she is
Stripe	__stripe_sid, __stripe_mid, __stripe_orig_props	For the online payments if Stripe is used
Paypal	cookie_check, rmuc, ts, tsrce, ui_experience, x-pp-s, PYPF, enforce_policy, id_token, login_email	For the online payments if Stripe is used
LinkedIn	last_linkedin_sync	Last LinkedIn synchronization date, to ask the user to synchronize his/her LinkedIn profile
Google analytics	_ga, _gid, _ga_thivebriteTracker	For tracking the traffic
